Specific Details:

Embossed burgundy leather covers with 21 of the 22 decorative brass studs intact, along with two pins.

MS is trapezoid: larger on inside than outside.

Magnificent headpieces and icons (see 123a for headpiece illustration).

Several leaves have tiny marginal notes, between the columns, on the sides, and on the tops and bottoms of the page.

1b: beautiful, gilded icon of John

2a: Johannine prologue

22, 97, 104, 137, 210, 219 [blank]: replacement paper leaves

41b–42a: tiny script, by later scribe.

42b: beautiful, gilded icon of Matthew

63a: lection in later hand

63b: beautiful, gilded icon of Luke

88b: beautiful, gilded icon of Mark

123a: beautiful, extremely detailed headpiece
