**Specific Details:**

Fairly modern cloth covers, spine loose.

NLG catalog (1892) says of the handwriting: γράμμασι λεπτειλέπτοις γεγραμμένον (“written in an exquisite hand”). The hand is rather petite.

1a: ‘7’ is written in pencil, along with ‘1’. The ‘7’ is pagination, the ‘1’ is foliation. At some time in the modern era, this MS had three more leaves that have now disappeared.

1b–3b: Eusebian canons

4: paper insert

4b: icon of Matthew

5a–43b: Matthew

5a: ornate headpiece for beginning of Matthew

43b–44a: κεφάλαια of Mark

44b: blank

45a–71a: Mark

45a: ornate headpiece for beginning of Mark, but less than for Matthew

70b: Mark 16.8, with lection ending noted (τελος)

71a–72a: κεφάλαια for Luke
