Hand has been retraced in several places.
Codex begins with the Johannine Prologue.
Spacing changes dramatically on f. 147 for a couple of pages. Instead of 30 lines per page, now there are 21-23. Appears to be the same hand though, except on 148 b . Then, on 149a the hand goes back to its normal spacing.
201a: different hand, later. 200b ended in the middle of John 18.39 ( $o v v \nu \mu \nu \nu \pi \rho \lambda v \sigma \omega$ ), but 201a does not continue this. Not biblical.
201b: back to the biblical text, former hand.
203a: another different hand. Lectionary abbreviations-e.g., $\boldsymbol{\rho} \boldsymbol{\gamma} \boldsymbol{\gamma} \tau \theta 0 \omega v$ (i.e., 153 fish)


$204 b$ is a final different hand. Abbreviations in four columns.
Altogether at least six different hands for this MS.
