#### **Specific Details:**

Thin leather over cardboard(?), modern covers. Detached; spine detached too.

Previous SN: ευαγγελιον 77

Hand has been retraced in several places.

Codex begins with the Johannine Prologue.

Spacing changes dramatically on f. 147 for a couple of pages. Instead of 30 lines per page, now there are 21–23. Appears to be the same hand though, except on 148b. Then, on 149a the hand goes back to its normal spacing.

201a: different hand, later. 200b ended in the middle of John 18.39 (ουν υμιν απολυσω), but 201a does not continue this. Not biblical.

201b: back to the biblical text, former hand.

203a: another different hand. Lectionary abbreviations—e.g., **ρνγ** ιχθυων (i.e., 153 fish) ... απαξ κατα τον Παυλον ... ο **Ιησους** κατα τον Ματθαιαν, κτλ.

204a is a different hand again. Some text: στι τι μοι ... τον ανθρωπον επι της γης...

204b is a final different hand. Abbreviations in four columns.

Altogether at least six different hands for this MS.

197a: lengthy colophon as follows: + Ἡ μὲν χεὶρ ἡ γράψασα σήπετε τάφω. τὸ δὲ γράμμα μένη εἰς χρόνους πληρεστάτους. — Ἐπληρώθη σὺν θεῶ. μηνὶ Φεβρουαρίου κγ΄, ἡμέρα παρασκευὴ, ὥρα β΄ Ἰνδικτιὧνος ια΄ τοῦ ἔτους ςφηζ΄ διὰ χειρὸς Ἀνδρέου νοταρίου καὶ καλλιγράφου καὶ εἶ τι ἐγίνετο ἄχρι ψιλοῦ σφάλμα τοῦτο διὰ τὸν Χριστὸν συγχωρήσατέ μοι. <sup>4</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Rough translation: "The hand that wrote [this] is rotting in the grave. But the letters remain until the fullness of time. Completed with [the help of] God. February 23, Friday, the second hour, during the eleventh indiction, in the year 1079 [or 1080] through the hand of Andrew, scribe and calligrapher, and if it happens that any error of omission [remains]—with reference to this, for the sake of Christ, forgive me."
