Specific Details:

Modern cloth cover, front detached, spine almost detached.

Lots of rubrication, some blue, some yellow.

MS has been trimmed at bottom edge.

MS is clean: few valleys, very flat. Seems to have been used rather infrequently. The only exception seems to be ff. 138–147.

1a: begins with the Johannine Prologue.

78a: nice headpiece for beginning of Markan lection.

138a–147b: different hand introduced into the MS; MS is noticeably dirtier, more worn.

198–200: blank (parchment)
