Front cover: 2 additional leaves + cover b = 5 images Back cover: 0 additional leaves + cover a = 1 images

Specific Details:

Wood boards covered with embossed leather; both male clasps intact, parts of straps also. Spine is split off from front cover.

Eusebian canons and lectionary markers, as well as title *numbers* throughout. Ink is black throughout; MS is rectangular with minimal trapezoid.

Front cover, first two leaves: from a different MS, not biblical. Text not yet identified. Definitely Christian (*nomina sacra*), perhaps patristic.

1a-2a: κεφαλαια for Matthew

3a-40b: Matthew

2b: originally blank, now with child's scribblings on it, including some rather imperfect copying of Matt 1.

3a: modestly ornate headpiece for Matthew

40b: end of Matthew written as an inverted pyramid

41ab: κεφαλαια for Mark

42a: modestly ornate headpiece for Mark

42a-65b: Mark

65ab: LE for Mark. Marginal note at 16.8, written in a later hand: τ[ελος] μρο[= Mark?] φου και τε ἐωθι.

65b-67a: numbered κεφαλαια for Luke

67b: blank, but with large holes in it; unsuitable for icon.

68a-108b: Luke

68a: modestly ornate headpiece for Luke

109a: κεφαλαια for John

109b: blank 110a–139b: John

110a: modestly ornate headpiece for John

139b: inverted pyramid for last ten lines of John.

140a-συνναξαριον του σαββατο[υ] κυριακών του αγιου ... [Synaxarion for the holy sabbath of the Lord's day]: extensive list of abbreviations and what is to be read.
