<sup>1</sup> The NLG catalog (1892) says it was written in the year 1311. This is assuming that the colophon date of **ϥοιθ** is read. INTF seems to assume that it actually read **ϥοφς**, or else they made a rather large error.

<sup>2</sup> MS was apparently upside down for some of its shelf life since the higher depth measurement is from the bottom of the codex.

The last leaf has this colophon:

+ Χριστὲ φιλόανθρωπε βασιλεῦ τῶν ἀπάντων παράσχου χάριν τῷ σῷ πιστῷ οἰκέτῃ  
Λέοντι ἀμαρτωλῷ τὸ (οὔτω) πόθῳ πολλῷ τῇ δέλτῳ κτησαμένῳ + ἅμα καὶ τῷ  
γράψαντι [ἄνευ?] πταισμάτων. Οἱ ἀναγνώσται εὐχ[εσθε] ὑπὲρ ἡμῶν διὰ Κύριον.  
Ἀμήν. Γένοιτο. Ἔτος **ξωιθ**<sup>3</sup>

The MS has been trimmed, with the outside smaller than the inside by as much as 1 cm.  
Also, the codex seems to have been trimmed on all three sides.

Lectionary begins with Johannine prologue.

<sup>3</sup> Rough translation: “+ Christ, lover of mankind, ruler of all. Give grace to your faithful servant, Leontos, a sinner who longs much for the writing table to be acquired + so that he may write [without] failings. Readers: pray for us because of the Lord. Amen. May it happen. In the year [6000+800+10+9 =] 6819.” INTF seems to assume that it actually read **ξφφς**, or else they made a large error (counting from Creation; that is, 5508 BCE, **ξωιθ** = 1311 CE; **ξφφς** = 1048 CE).
