Modern cloth covers.

Minimal ornamentation.

1–2: much later Greek text, nonprofessional.

MS appears to have hardly ever been used. Some leaves look brand new; a few have more than 1 or 2 wax drippings. Toward the end (c. 250ff.), the usage gets dramatically heavier. As a single-column MS with these signs of wear, it seems to have been a privately used MS, not one for divine worship.
