<sup>1</sup> The codex in which these buffer leaves were inserted is a late paper MS, dated 1507.

<sup>2</sup> The leaves are inserted diagonally to the rest of the MS. One leaf, folded in half, is in the front; the same in the back.

<sup>3</sup> Not all the lines are visible since the leaves were inserted into the codex diagonally.

<sup>4</sup> The measurements are based on the leaves as they are, but with the folds the full length is not easily detectable. The width, however, is complete. How Münster arrived at the dimensions they did is a mystery.

<sup>5</sup> For purposes of shooting, there are four leaves (8 images) since each half-leaf must be shot on its own.

The paper MS before and after which these leaves are used as a buffer in the codex includes some leaves from the pseudepigraphical Apocalypse of John the Theologian. The catalog description says, *Αποκαλυψις του αγιου Ιωαννου του Θεολογου περι της δευτερας παρουσιας και της συντελειας, λεγομενη δε τη Κυριακη της Τυρινης (εξ ης απεκοπησας εν τελει φυλλα 4. Εστι δε ψευδεπιγραφος).*

<sup>6</sup> For purposes of shooting, there are four leaves (8 images) since each half-leaf must be shot on its own.

<sup>7</sup> Leaf numbers: *actual* is listed first, then =, then the *written* number on the MS in single quotes. Thus: 214a = '212a'. Even though the quotation marks are used, there is no 'a' on the written page. For a MS that is paginated, the *actual leaf* number is listed first, followed by =, followed by the *page number* in quotes. Thus: 214a = '423'.
