Elegant hand with magnificent icons.

The MS is a complete NT, with only non-biblical text missing.

Trapezoid: at times larger on top than bottom and on inside than outside.

Extensive rubricated marginalia throughout.

1–6 & 7–8: material added by later scribe, as is evident by quire count starting on folio 9
