Specific Details:

Wood boards covered with embossed leather; still largely intact except for the spine. Inside cover as number 12, 148, and 63 as well. MS appears to have survived a fire, with only the edges getting charred. 3a-4a: κεφάλαια for Matthew 4b[.] blank 5a–76a: Matthew 5a: ornate headpiece for Matthew 76a–76b: κεφάλαια for Mark 77a: blank 77b-122a: Mark 77b: ornate headpiece for Mark 121b: after $\varepsilon \phi \sigma \beta \sigma v \tau \sigma \gamma \alpha \rho$ of 16.8, an $\alpha \rho \gamma \eta$ appears in the margin, signaling the next pericope for reading. 122b-123b: κεφάλαια for Luke 124a–201b: Luke 124a: ornate headpiece for Luke 201b: Luke's Gospel ends in the shape of a cross. 202a: κεφάλαια for John 202b-258b: John 223b-224a: PA 259a-265a: lectionary abbreviations
