Specific Details:

MS has been in a fire, as the cloth protective bag indicates with ϕ (for $\phi \omega \tau \iota \alpha$). Blue velvet cover.

Formerly known as χειρογραφο 419 (acquired in 1939?)—see front inside cover. But first additional-matter leaf says 1905, and the first additional-matter leaf in the back says 9 May 1905.

Rubrication very faint

1a of additional matter: handwritten description, including date of IX. Because the text is infralinear it cannot be earlier than XI.

92b: heading with blue ink (first one observed in MS)
